

**TANGIPAHOA PARISH, LA.**

The Tangipahoa Parish Government is accepting proposals and procuring the services of an experienced planning consulting firm, with appropriate expertise in land use regulations, in order to assist Tangipahoa Parish with the preparation and codification of existing Land Development regulations, and its amendments, for Tangipahoa Parish.

The procedures for the selection of this firm will be in accordance with the procurement requirements of Tangipahoa Parish. All responses received will be evaluated in accordance with the selection criteria identified in the request for proposals information, available with more detail from the Parish. That information available to those interested also identifies the scope of work to be performed by the selected consultant, as well as the selection criteria.

The Parish will award a contract to the respondent obtaining the highest recommendation based upon a Parish selection committee review of the written RFPs. The top two rated respondents may be asked to provide detailed proposed fee and cost information, timing, availability, background, etc. which will be reviewed by the Parish for cost reasonableness and the Parish may choose the use of oral interviews with these top two candidates.
