## GENERAL BIDDING REQUIREMENTS

Bid security is required and contractors shall be in good standing and licensed with the state of Louisiana. The bid must be properly signed, the proposal completed both in numbers and script, and include bidder's Louisiana License Number.

The LA Revised Statutes require that all public works be governed by criteria as set forth by the LA-DOTD and approved by the Chief Engineer of that Agency. The specifications, contract and bonds governing the construction of all public works are contained in the Louisiana Standard Specifications for Roads and Bridges, 2006 edition, together with any supplementary specifications and special provisions attached to this proposal. All prospective bidders are advised that they must be familiar with these requirements if they desire to bid on any public works. The lack of knowledge in this particular may jeopardize the acceptance of future bids.

The plans herein referred to, if any, are the plans approved and marked with the project name, together with all standard or special designs necessary to illustrate the requirements of the public works.

As a condition of this proposal, the bidder declares that he employs no person, corporation, firm, association or other organization, either directly or indirectly, to secure the public contract under which he received payment, other than persons regularly employed by the bidder whose services in connection with the construction, alteration, or demolition of this project or in securing the public contract were in the regular course of their duties for bidder; and that no part of the contract price received by bidder was paid or will be paid to any person, corporation, firm, association, or other organization for soliciting the contract, other than the payment of their normal services in connection with the construction, alteration, or demolition of this project were in the regular course of their duties for bidder; that careful examination has been made of the site of the proposed work, the plans, standard specifications mentioned and the form of contract and contract bond; that the bidder agrees, if this proposal is accepted, to provide all necessary machinery, tools, apparatus, and other means of construction and will do all work and furnish all material specified in the contract, in the manner and time therein prescribed and in accordance with the requirements therein set forth; and agrees to accept as full compensation therefore, the amount of the summation of the products of the quantities of work and material incorporated in the completed project, as determined by the Engineer.

It is understood by the bidder that the quantities given in this proposal are a fair approximation of the amount of work to be done and that the sum of the products of these approximate quantities shall constitute the gross sum bid which sum shall be used in comparison of bids and awarding of the contract. The bidder's attention is directed to the sheet listing the items and bidder is advised that the sums must be entered as directed by the item. The failure to do so may jeopardize the bid. The project estimated cost is \$455,000.00.

The bidder agrees to execute such change orders as are necessary to fulfill the contract; that he will execute the contract and furnish performance and payment bonds in a timely manner.

### INSURANCE

The Contractor agrees to obtain and continuously maintain, during the life of this contract, such insurance as will protect the Tangipahoa Parish Government and the Contractor from claims for damages because of bodily injury, including death to his employees and all others; and for claims for damages to property and/or all of which may arise from the contractor's operation by anyone directly or indirectly employed by him.

The insurance to be carried by the contractor, certificates of which are to be furnished to the Tangipahoa Parish Government, is noted as follows:

Workman's Compensation Insurance and Employer's Liability Insurance in amounts sufficient to comply with the laws of Louisiana, including the Jones Act and U.S.L. and Harbor Worker's Compensation.

Comprehensive General Public Liability Insurance in the amount of \$300,000.00 for injury or death of an individual and \$900,000.00 for injury or death of more than an individual in any one occurrence, and Property Damages Insurance with limits of \$300,000.00 for any one occurrence.

Automobile Insurance in the amount of \$300,000.00 for injury or death of one person and \$1,000,000.00 for injury or death of more than one person in any one occurrence and Property Damage Insurance to the extent of \$250,000.00 as an aggregate for each occurrence.

The bidder's attention is directed to the requirements of the certificates. He must furnish that certificate upon bid of any project. Thereafter, he may maintain a file copy with the required update at the office of the Tangipahoa Parish Government. Failure to provide this certificate initially will disqualify the bid.

These requirements are subject to change as state law may be amended and insurance companies adjust their rates. These changes will be made available to all prospective bidders.

## SPECIAL PROVISIONS

### PAYMENT ADJUSTMENT

This project is designated for payment adjustment for asphalt cements in accordance with DOTD Standard Specifications - See Special Provision "Pay Adjustment"

#### 109-09 PAYMENT ADJUSTMENT (ASPHALT CEMENTS).

(a) General: Payment for contract items indicated herein will be adjusted to compensate for cost differentials of Performance Graded (PG) asphalt cements, when such costs increase or decrease more than five (5) percent from the Department's established base prices for these items. The base price indices for asphalt cements will be the monthly price indices in effect at the time bids are opened for the project. The base price indices for asphalt cements will be as stated in paragraph (b) below.

Payment adjustments will be made each monthly estimate period when a price index for this period varies more than 5 percent from its respective base price index. The monthly price indices to be used with each monthly estimate will be the price indices for the month in which the estimate period begins.

(b) Performance Graded (PG) Asphalt Cements: The base price index will be the monthly price index in effect at the time of bid opening as shown elsewhere herein. The monthly price indices will be the average, excluding the extreme outliers, of the unit prices for PG 64-22, the average, excluding the extreme outliers, of the unit prices for PG 70-22m, and the average, excluding the extreme outliers, of the unit prices for PG 76-22m. The monthly prices for each of these asphalt materials will be F.O.B. refinery or terminal as determined from the quoted prices effective on the first calendar day of each month from suppliers of these materials. Suppliers considered are those who have requested to participate in the liquid asphalt index determination and have supplied materials on DOTD projects within the past twelve months. These suppliers and materials shall be listed on the Department's Qualified Products List (QPL 41) and must be marketed in Louisiana.

Payment adjustments will be made in accordance with the following formulas:

If Monthly Price Index exceeds Base Price Index,  
$$P = (A - 1.05B) \times C \times D \times (1.00 + T)$$

If Base Price Index exceeds Monthly Price Index,  
$$P = (0.95B - A) \times C \times D \times (1.00 + T)$$

Where

- P = Price adjustment (increase or decrease) for asphalt cement.  
A = Monthly Price Index for respective PG 64-22, PG 70-22m, or PG 76-22m in dollars per ton /megagram.  
B = Base Price Index for respective PG 64-22, PG 70-22m, or PG 76-22m in dollars per ton / megagram.  
C = Tons / megagrams of asphaltic concrete.  
D = Percent of respective asphalt cement, per job mix formula, in decimals.  
T = Louisiana sales tax percentage, in decimals.  
(Note: Local tax is not considered)

The engineer will furnish the weights (mass) of asphalt concrete placed during the monthly estimate period with the respective asphalt cement content, excluding the asphalt content in reclaimed asphaltic pavement (RAP) as per job mix formula. If the asphalt cement content changes during the estimate period, the respective weight (mass) of asphaltic concrete produced at each cement content will be reported.

No payment adjustment will be made for other asphalt materials, including emulsions and cutbacks. The base price indices for asphalt cements and fuels will be posted on the DOTD internet website before the 10th calendar day of each month. <http://www.dotd.louisiana.gov/lettings/lac>

## SPECIAL PROVISIONS

### SIGNS & BARRICADES

The Contractor will provide adequate signs, barricades, and warning devices to protect the public and his personnel and minimize inconvenience to vehicular traffic. This may include lighting devices at night and during inclement weather to adequately warn of personnel, equipment, materials and/or work sites that are left in a hazardous location or condition. Such signs, barricades and warning devices shall be **appropriately** and **timely** placed before work commences and be **timely** removed when work is completed. The costs incurred in this operation will be reflected in bid items and, of itself, be due no monies. All construction and advance construction signs must be removed within ten (10) days after a section of road overlay is completed. Note: Completion of a road consists of completion of work and installing permanent striping.

### UTILITIES

The Contractor will familiarize himself with existing utilities in the areas of his operations and coordinate any removals and/or relocations with the affected utility company and hold the Parish harmless in this regard.

### RIGHT-OF-WAY

The Contractor is advised that no additional rights-of-way or servitudes were acquired and will confine his operation and storage of equipment to the existing roadways. The Contractor may make any arrangements with adjacent property owners that he deems necessary without the Parish being a party thereto.

As stated in the Pre-Bid Conference for this Project, this contract may be extended both by quantity and date.

### FUND ALLOCATIONS

The Contractor will be paid monthly estimates in accordance with bid items with 5% retainage. Retainage to be paid when project is complete and after a forty-five (45) day lien period. If the costs of the bid items overrun the estimate, the Parish reserves the right to reduce or eliminate items and/or certain roads. The Parish will, however, attach a list of priorities to assist the bidder in preparing his proposal. The roads are listed in priority order and their quantities estimated accordingly. Any changes to be made to the priority list by the contractor must be pre-approved by the Public Works Director or his designee prior to beginning work activities. Any questions concerning this should be directed to the Office of the Tangipahoa Parish Government Public Works Director as soon as possible.

### ITEM 203-05 - SHOULDER MATERIAL (BORROW PIT OR EQUAL)

This item should consist of soils as recommended in Item 203.05 and should be placed in areas of shoulders as recommended by Public Works Director or his designee. Not all roadways will need shoulder materials placed. Materials should be compacted and placed to drain into ditches or front slope. Material derived from tight blading shall not serve as a substitute for required shoulder material. Shoulder restoration must be completed within 14 days after each section of road has been overlaid. Rain days will be considered. RAP shall be placed on shoulders approaching and departing all mailboxes where needed. RAP or approved soils shall be placed and compacted on shoulders that has a drop-off of 2 inches in depth or greater. Areas of roadway with drop-offs less than 2 inches with high traffic volumes will be backfilled and compacted on a case by case basis as directed by the Public Works Director or his designee.

### ITEM 301-01 - BASE AND / OR SHOULDER MATERIAL A-4 OR BETTER

This item should consist of soils for soil cement base course of materials that will stabilize with cement in accordance with LA-DOTD designations: RT423 - such materials are those soils classified as A-A1, A-1B, A-2-4, A-2-6, A-3, A-4 AND A-6.

**NOTE: All Existing Surfaced Roads shall be Cored to Determine Condition of base and sub-base.**

## SPECIAL PROVISIONS

### ITEM 303-01 & 303-01 A - IN PLACE CEMENT STABILIZED BASE COURSE

This item shall consist of adding A-4 material or better, if needed, scarifying, pulverizing, blending, shaping, and stabilizing all materials to a homogenous texture to a depth as shown on the list of roads with six percent (6%) for item 303(01) and eight percent (8%) for item 303(01)A Portland Cement by volume. The cross slope shall adequately drain and the final profile shall approximate the original. **Surfacing must be applied within 5 days of stabilization or cold planing.** Traffic to be maintained at all times by the Contractor. In the event that a roadway becomes deteriorated due to the contractor failing to complete the road in the specified timeframe, the contractor shall be required to make all necessary repairs to the roadway prior to laying asphalt at no direct cost to the parish. Rain days will be considered on a case by case basis however, the contractor shall resume work immediately after weather events which will include weekend work if necessary. If a road has not been maintained and/or completed in the allotted timeframe not associated with weather conditions; the contractor will automatically be subjected to an assessment of stipulated damages in the amount of \$500.00 per day until the road is completed.

### ITEM 501-01 - ASPHALTIC CONCRETE (2" COMPACTED)

Job mix formula to conform to DOTD 2006 Specifications for level A asphalt. The same type will be used throughout the contract. The straight edge is eliminated. Shoulder material will be pulled back to surface when complete. When leveling is required, it will be placed in single lifts. No lifts greater than 2" - 2½" will be placed in any single operation. Ramps will be placed at all turnouts. The depths and widths will be determined by the Director of Public Works or his designee. Aprons will be placed at all driveways at a minimum of three feet (3') from the edge of the road surface and a minimum of five feet (5') from the edge on all turnouts for parish roads. Patching over cross-drains may be required as directed by the Public Works Director or his designee. Patches must be in place at least 5 days prior to Cold Planing. All butt joints must be saw cut at no additional cost.

### ASPHALT PRIME COAT (NO DIRECT PAY)

### ITEM 502-07A - WEATHER LIMITATIONS

Asphalt materials shall not be applied on a wet surface or when ambient air temperature is less than 50°F in the shade; however, when a road has been cold planed and weather restricts the contractor from completing the roadway, the contractor shall be responsible for maintaining a safe riding surface until the work resumes or road is completed.

### ITEM 505-01 - DESCRIPTION

This work consists of preparing and treating a surface with asphalt material in conformance with these specifications and in conformity with lines shown on the plans or established. A Distributor with Prime must be available at all times.

### ITEM 505-02 - ASPHALTIC MATERIALS

Prime coat shall be cutback asphalt Grade MC-30, MC-70, or AEP Emulsified Asphalt complying with Section 1002.

### ITEM 505-04 - EQUIPMENT

The contractor shall provide the necessary equipment for proper construction of the work. Equipment shall be approved before construction begins and shall be maintained in satisfactory working condition. Equipment shall conform to Subsection 503.14.

### ITEM 505-05 - SURFACE PREPARATION

**Prime coat must be applied within 24 hours weather permitting.**

The surface to be coated shall be shaped to required grade and section, shall be free from ruts, corrugations, segregated material or other irregularities, and shall be compacted to required density. Delays in priming may necessitate reprocessing or reshaping to provide a smooth, compacted surface. A Distributor with Prime must be available at all times.

## SPECIAL PROVISIONS

### ITEM 505-06 - APPLICATION

Prime coat shall extend 6 inches (150mm) beyond the width of surfacing shown on the plans. The prime coat shall not be applied until the surface has been satisfactorily prepared and is dry. Prime coat shall be applied at the rates and temperatures shown in Table 505-1. Quantities of prime coat shall not vary from that shown in Table 505-1.

### ITEM 505-07 - PROTECTION

After prime coat has been applied it shall cure for a minimum of 24 hours before the surfacing is placed. The contractor shall keep traffic off the surface until the prime coat has properly cured, unless otherwise permitted. If traffic is permitted, the contractor may be required to spread approved granular material, as directed, over the prime coat at no direct pay. The prime coat shall be maintained intact. When required, the primed surface shall be thoroughly cleaned prior to the placement of surfacing. Where the prime coat has failed, the failed area shall be cleaned and be recoated with prime coat at no direct pay. When the prime coat is generally unsatisfactory, the contractor shall re-prime the unsatisfactory surface at no direct pay.

### ITEM 509-01 –COLD PLANING ASPHALTIC PAVEMENT

Cold planing pavement should be to a depth of 2" + or - depending on surface of roadway and paid for by the square yard. Where feasible all cold planed material shall be premixed into base. Cold planed material that is not used on the job will be 50% retained by the Contractor and 50% transferred to the Parish. **RAP placed around mailboxes to be deducted from Parish's portion. The storage sites for the Parish's portion of RAP is located at 106 North Street, Amite, La. 70422 for the north and 44512 W. Pleasant Ridge Road, Hammond, La. 70403 for the south.**

### ITEM 713-06 - TEMPORARY STRIPING

Color, width and type of temporary pavement marking shall be in accordance with table 713-1 of the MUTCD. Temporary pavement marking shall be in place at the end of each day's operation at no direct pay. Temporary striping tape shall be applied by approved methods to the satisfaction of the on-site inspector. Temporary pavement markers shall be placed as close to the center of the roadway as possible to avoid narrow lanes. Thermoplastic pavement marking shall be applied in accordance with subsection 742.03. Painted traffic striping shall be applied in accordance with section 737.

## SPECIAL PROVISIONS

### ITEM 727-01 - MOBILIZATION:

This Work Consists of Preparatory Work and Operations, including those necessary for movement of personnel, equipment, supplies, and incidentals to the project site; The establishment of offices, buildings, and other facilities necessary for work on the project; the cost of bond and any required insurance; and other preconstruction materials.

Mobilization shall not exceed 10% of the original total contract amount, including this item.

### ITEM 732-02 - PLASTIC PAVEMENT STRIPING SOLID LINE

The thermoplastic marking material where required shall be four (4") inches wide and applied in a solid line along the edge of pavement as directed by the Public Works Director or his designee.

### ITEM 732-03 - PLASTIC PAVEMENT STRIPING BROKEN LINE

The thermoplastic marking material where required (on roadways 18' or greater in width) four (4") inches in width by ten (10') feet in length is to be placed along road centerline at intervals of forty (40') feet center-to-center unless otherwise directed by the Public Works Director or his designee.

## General Notes

### STIPULATED DAMAGES

If a road has not been maintained and/or completed in the allotted timeframe not associated with weather conditions or excusable delays, the contractor will automatically be subjected to an assessment of stipulated damages in the amount of \$500.00 per day and per road until the road is completed.
