

Situation Overview



- Daily shower and T'storm chances continue (locally heavy rainfall possible)
- Coastal Flood impacts begin to decrease
- Slightly less coverage of showers and T'storms early and mid week next week
- Pretty much the same story different week

Tropical Weather Outlook



- A tropical wave is forecast to move into less favorable conditions west of the islands.
- The tropical Atlantic is forecast to remain quiet over the next 5 days



Valid Today






 Minor coastal flooding can't be ruled out during high tides cycles. A Coastal Flood Advisory is out until 7pm tonight. Tides begin to level off going into the upcoming weekend.

Excessive Rainfall Outlook

Today and Tonight






- Marginal risk of excessive rainfall areawide today and tonight.
- Rainfall may produce localized flooding, especially over urbanized or other flood prone areas.

Excessive Rainfall Outlook

Tomorrow and Tomorrow Night






 More excessive rainfall on Friday again for the entire forecast area. Localized flooding will continue to remain possible.

Storm Total Rainfall Forecast

Valid Thursday through Wednesday





- Rainfall generally one to three inches over the next week. Locally higher amounts expected in thunderstorms.
- Best odds late this week and into the weekend.

Summary of Impacts

- Summerlike pattern continues with daily showers and thunderstorms expected. Heavy rainfall is the primary threat with localized urban flooding possible over the next few days.
- Coastal Flood Advisory expires at 7pm tonight. Should continue to improve through the weekend.
