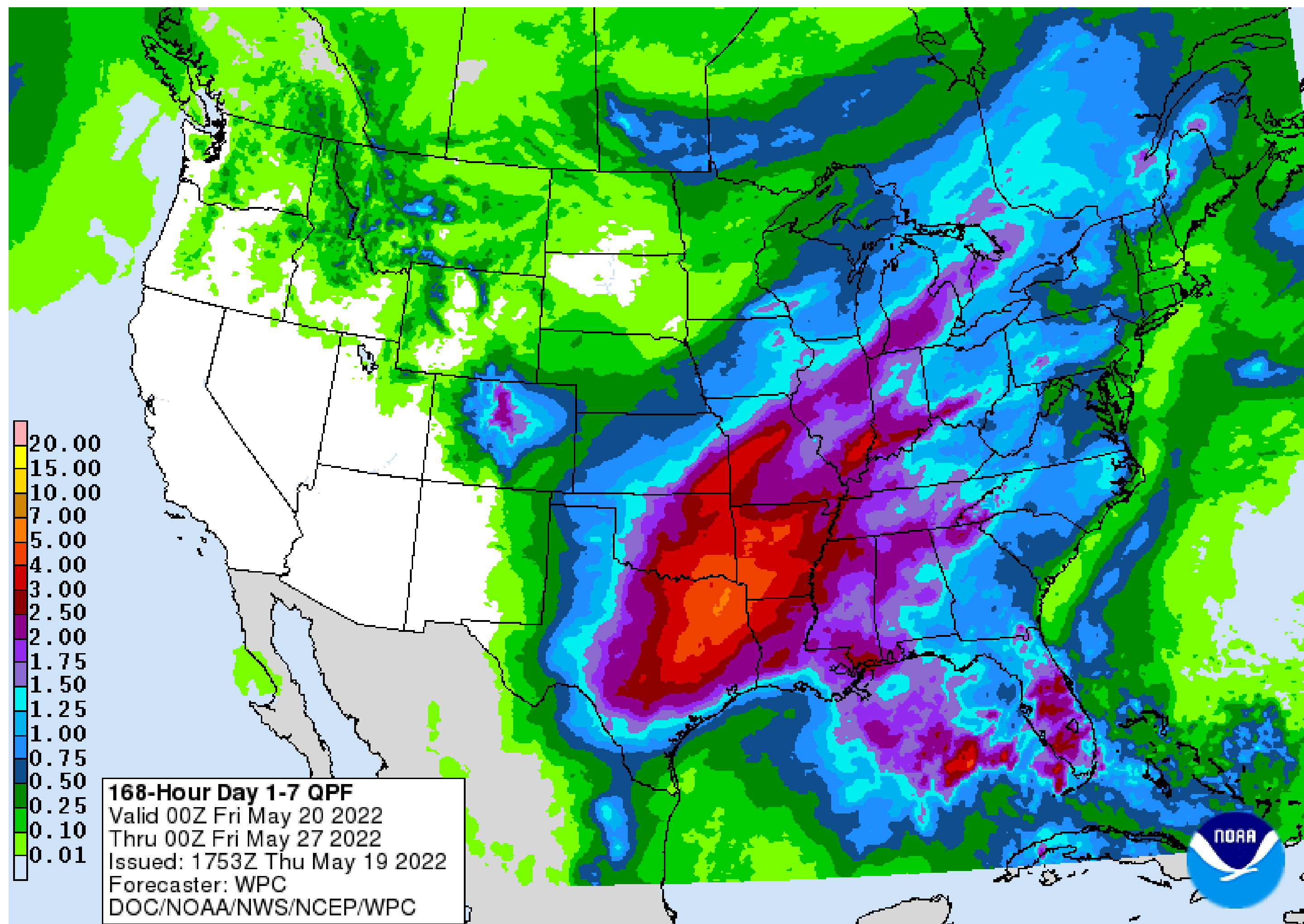

Storm Total Rainfall Forecast

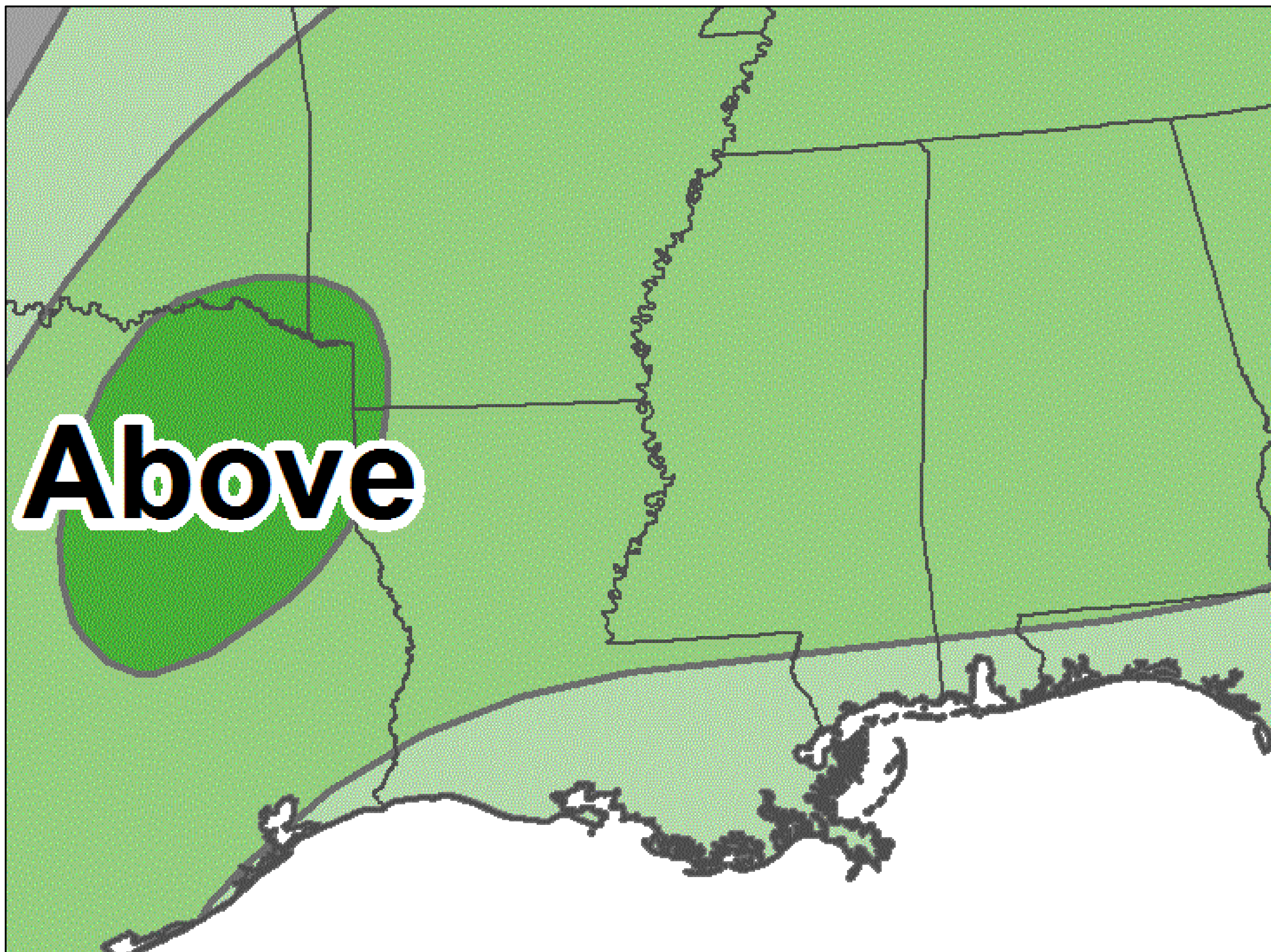
Valid Today through Thursday



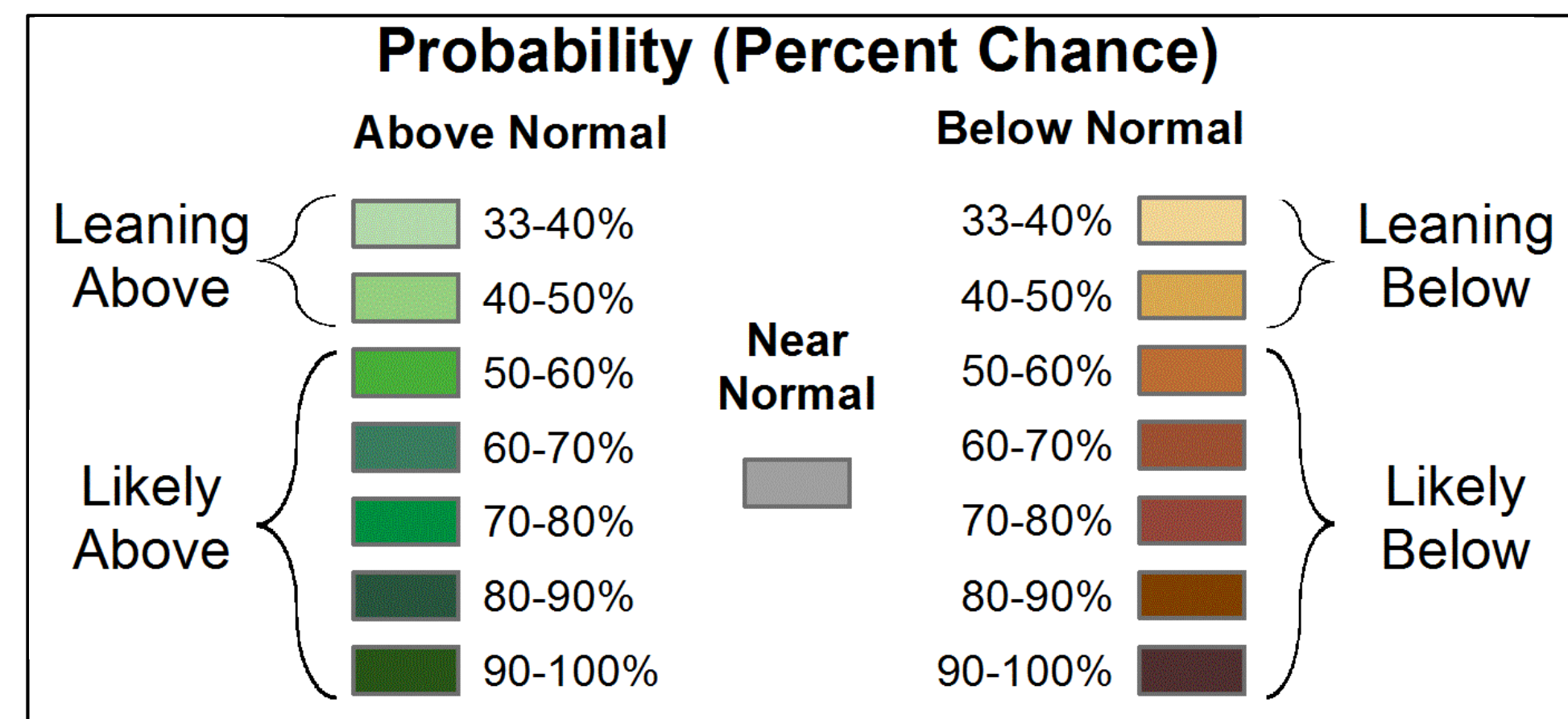
- Off and on rain chances Sunday through Thursday

Day 6-10 Rainfall Outlook

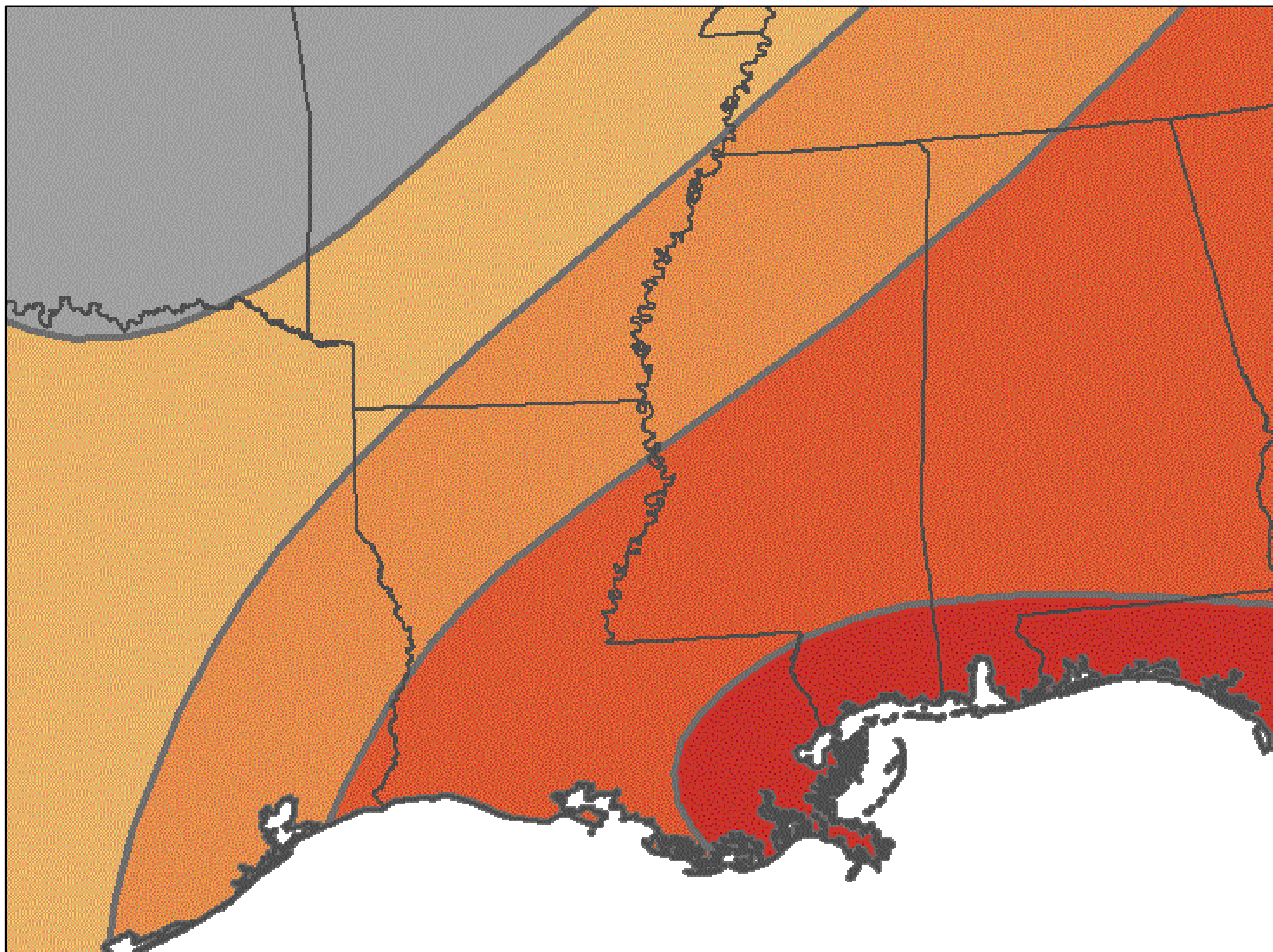


- Dry period coming to an end with increased rain chances most of next week.

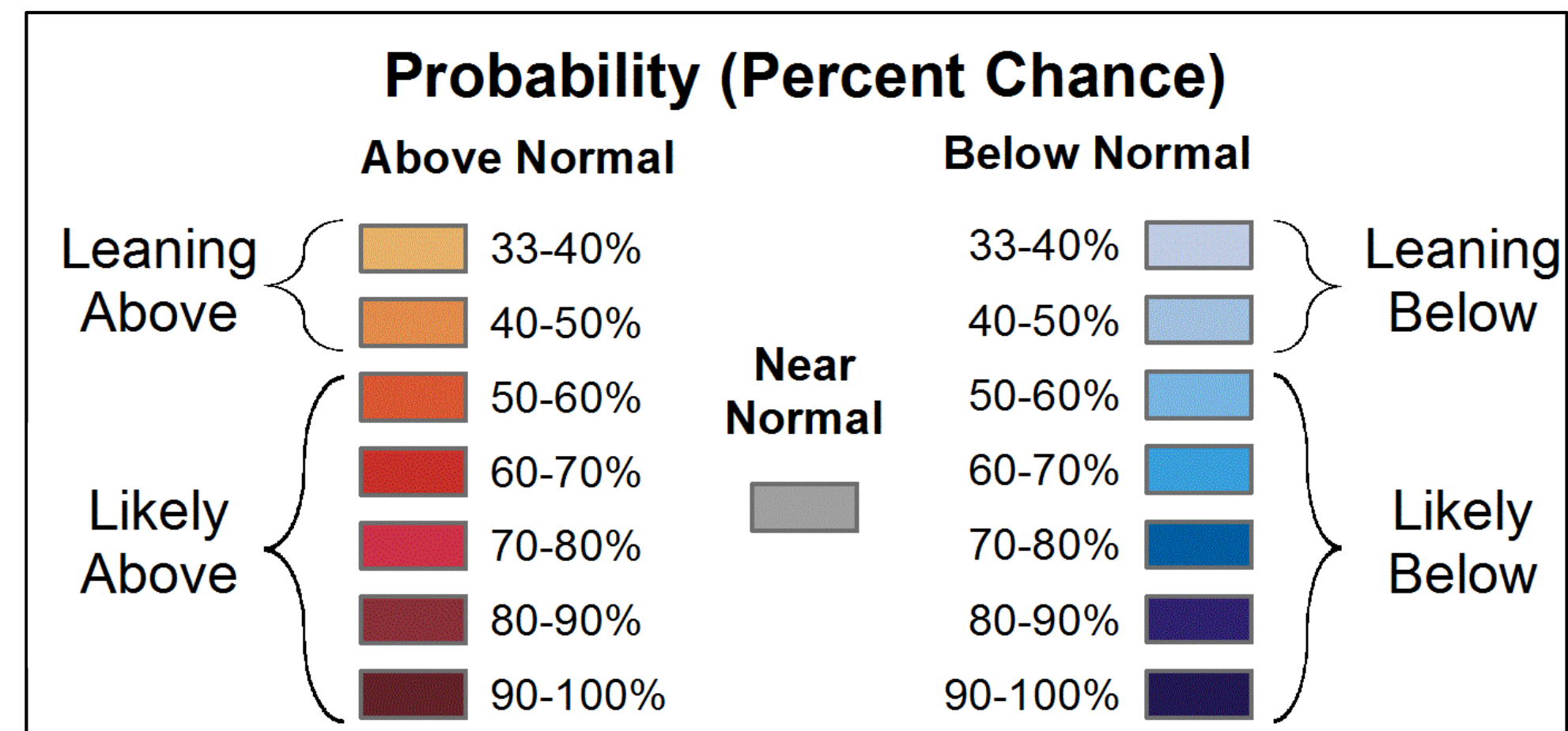




Day 6-10 Temperature Outlook
