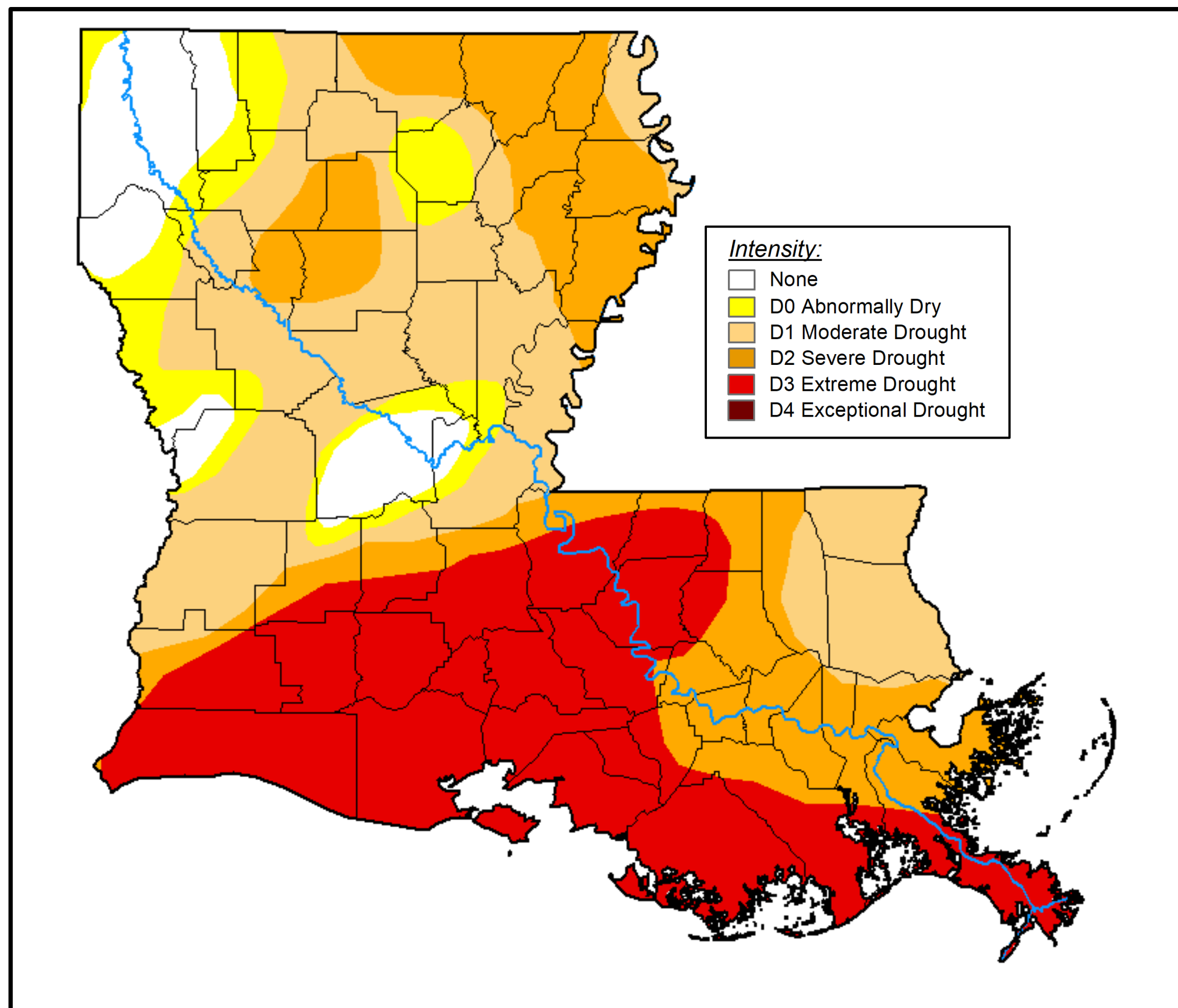
Situation Overview

- Next more notable rain and storm chances arrive Wednesday and Thursday.

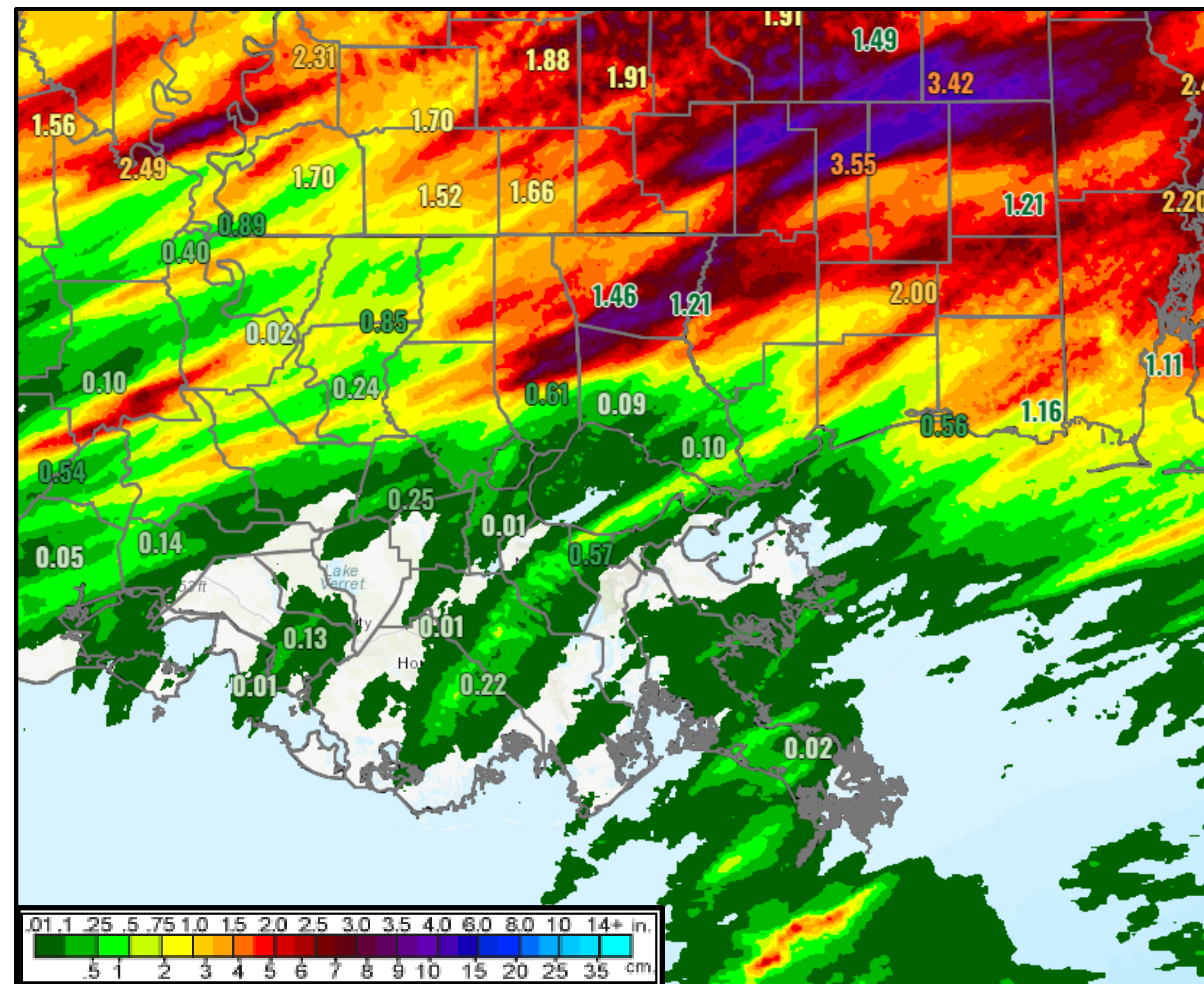


Drought Monitor & Recent Rainfall Totals

Louisiana Drought Monitor: Released 4/5/22

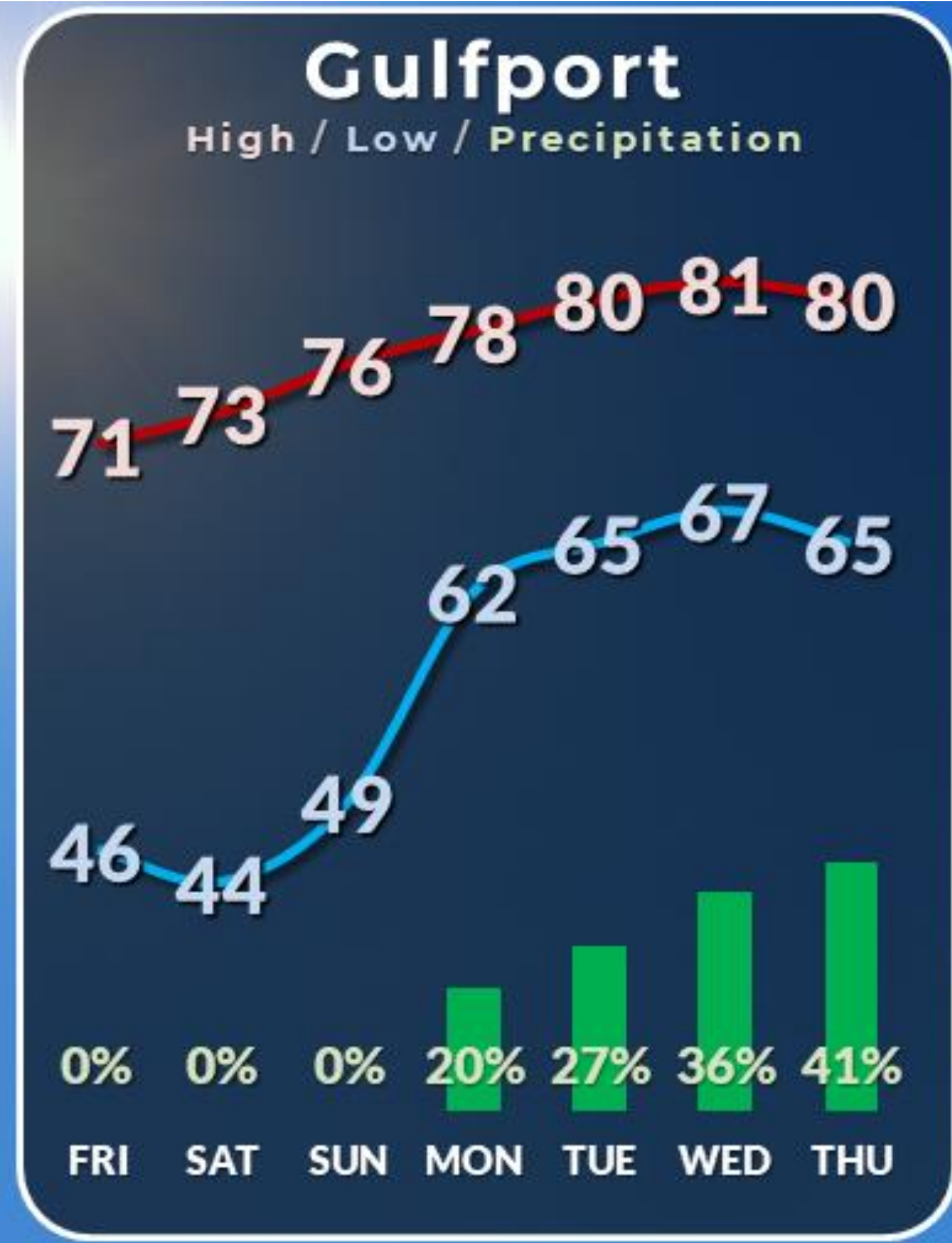
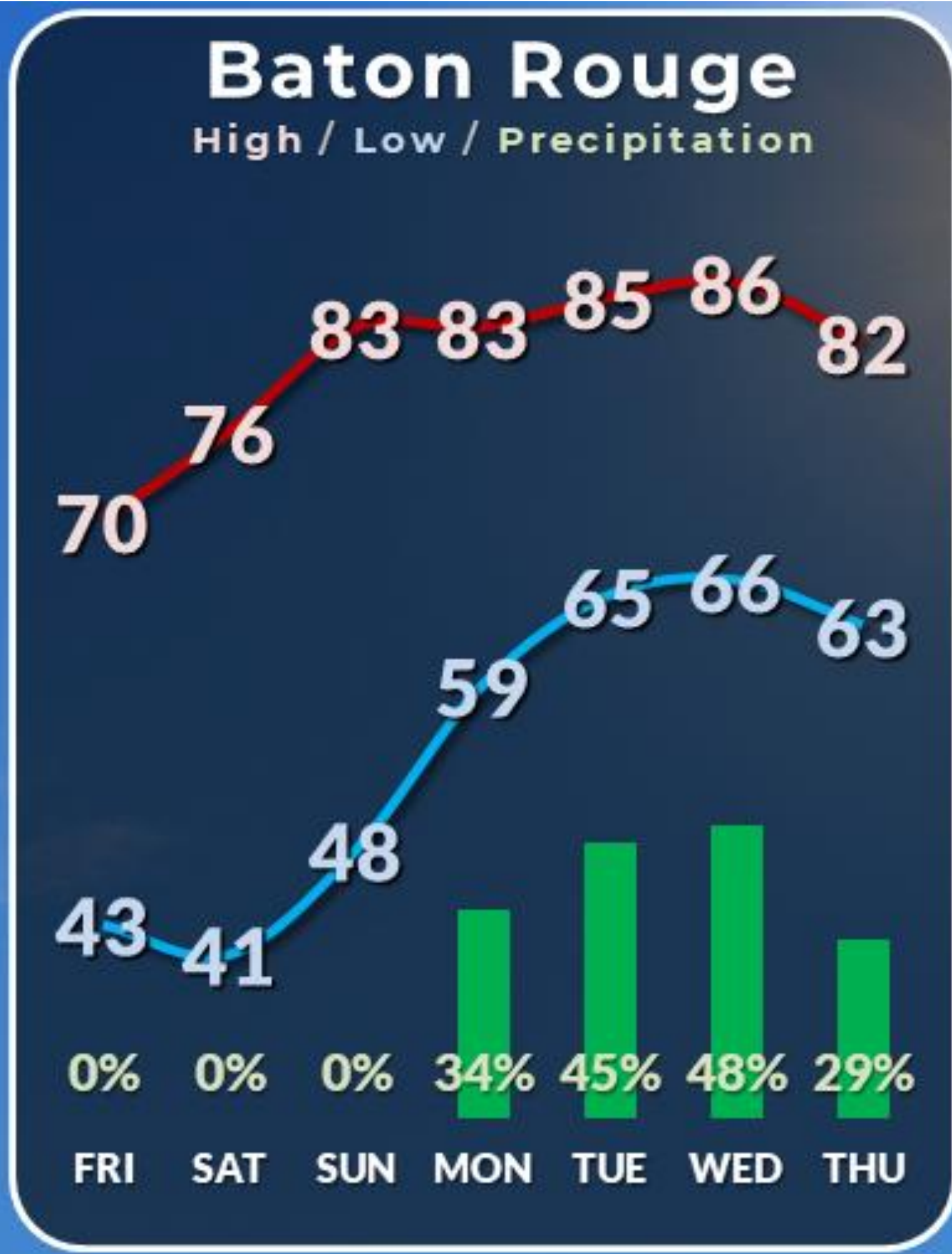
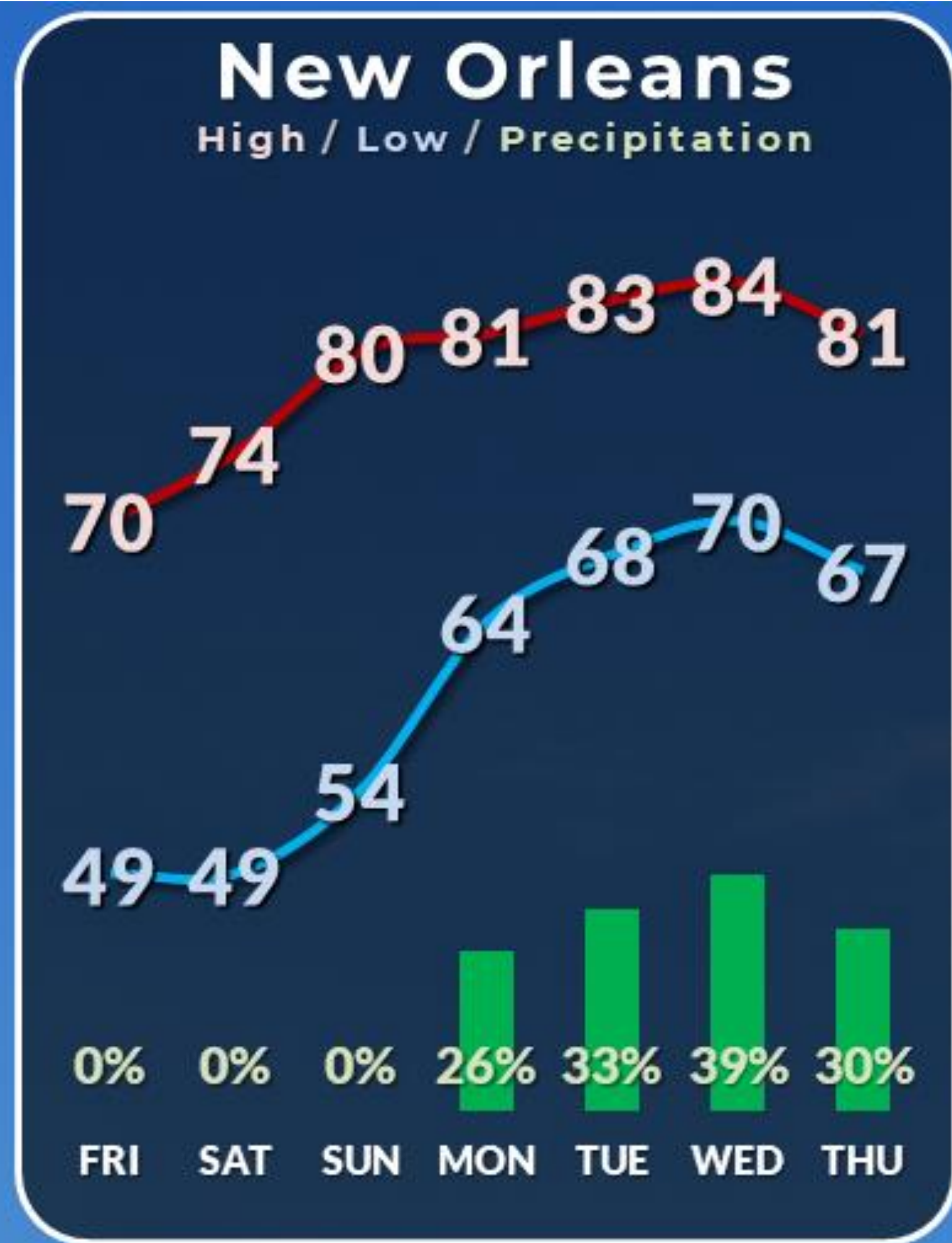


3 Day Rainfall Totals: 8AM Mon 4/4 thru 8AM Thu 4/7



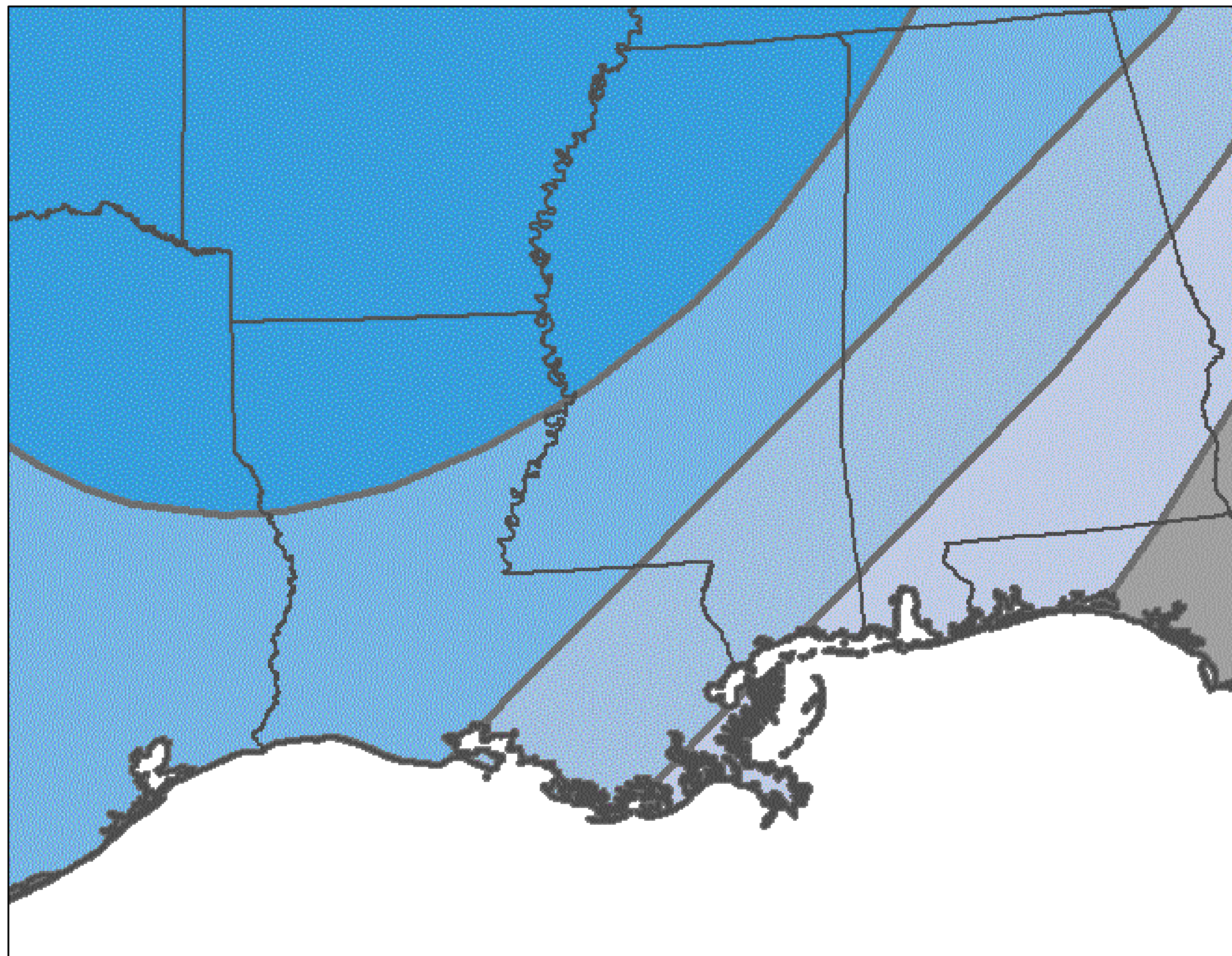


Seven Day Forecast

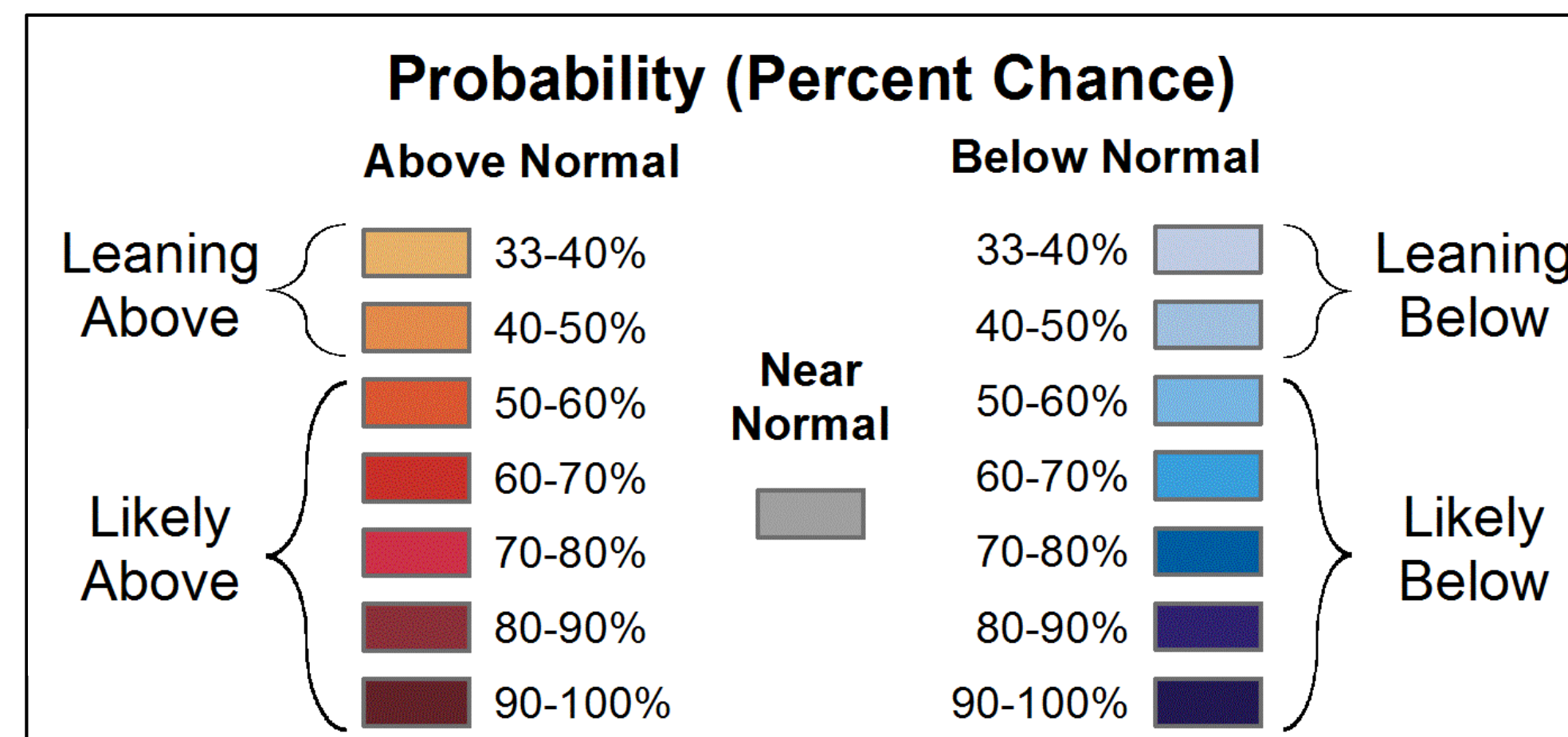




Day 8-14 Temperature Outlook

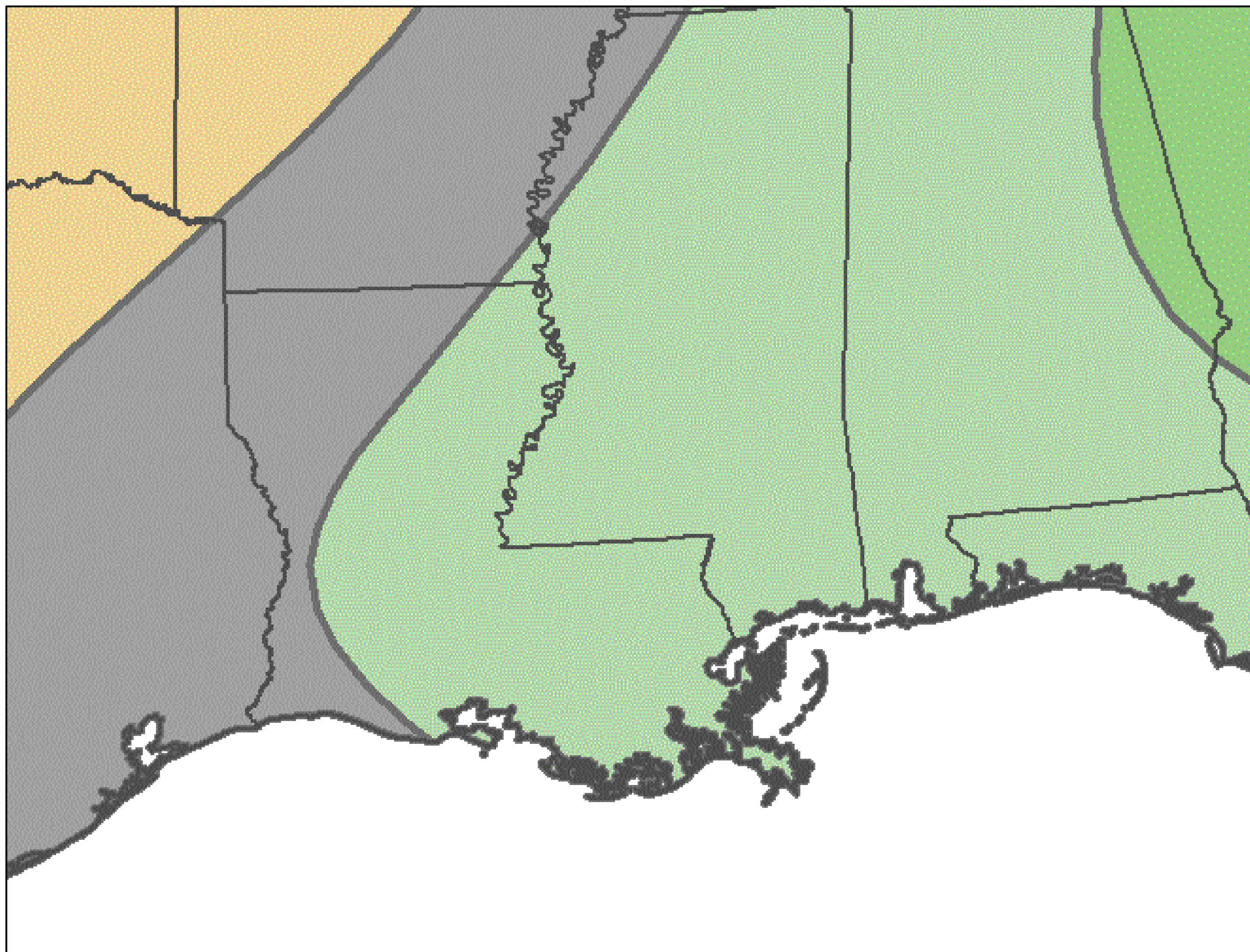


- Temperature outlook beyond next week is trending below normal for mid/late April.

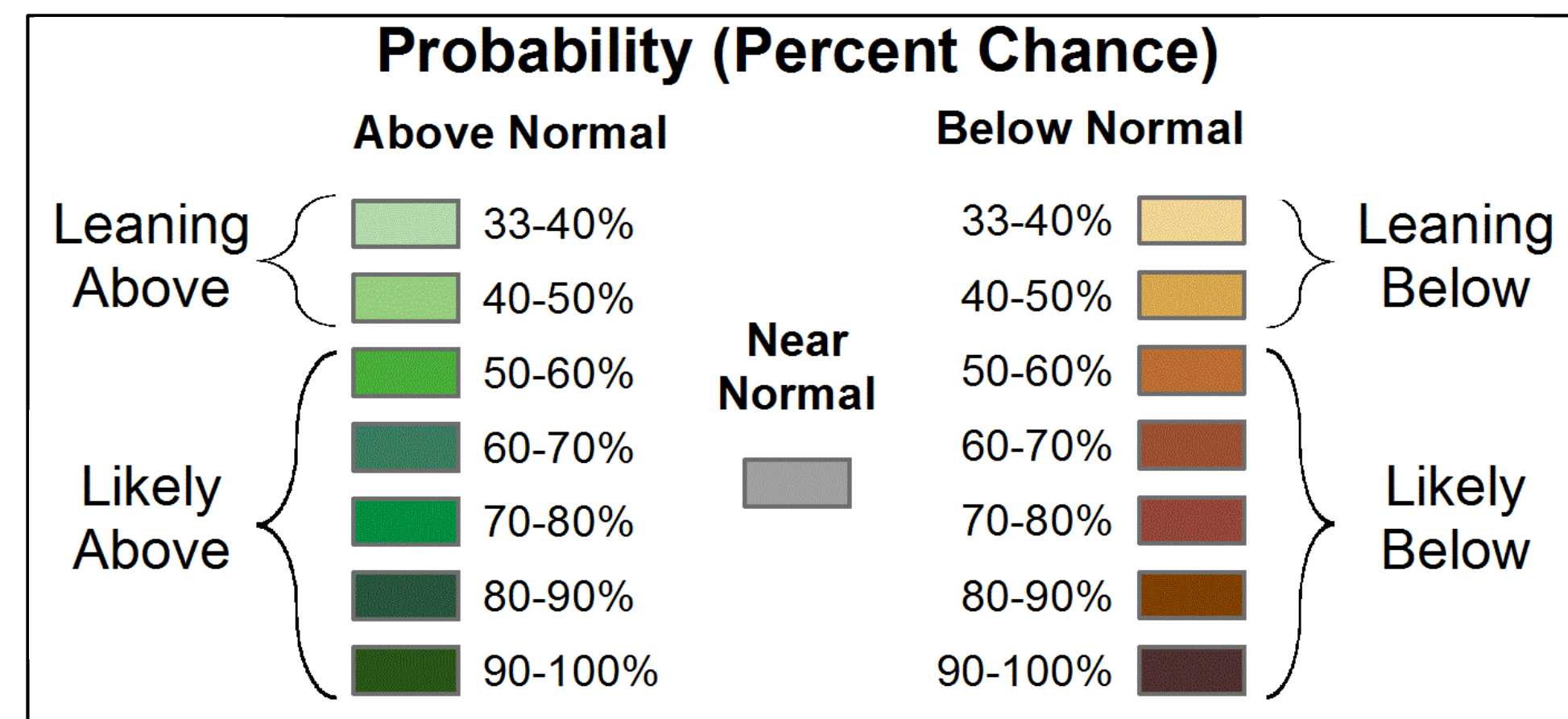




Day 8-14 Rainfall Outlook
