- Tropics remain quiet



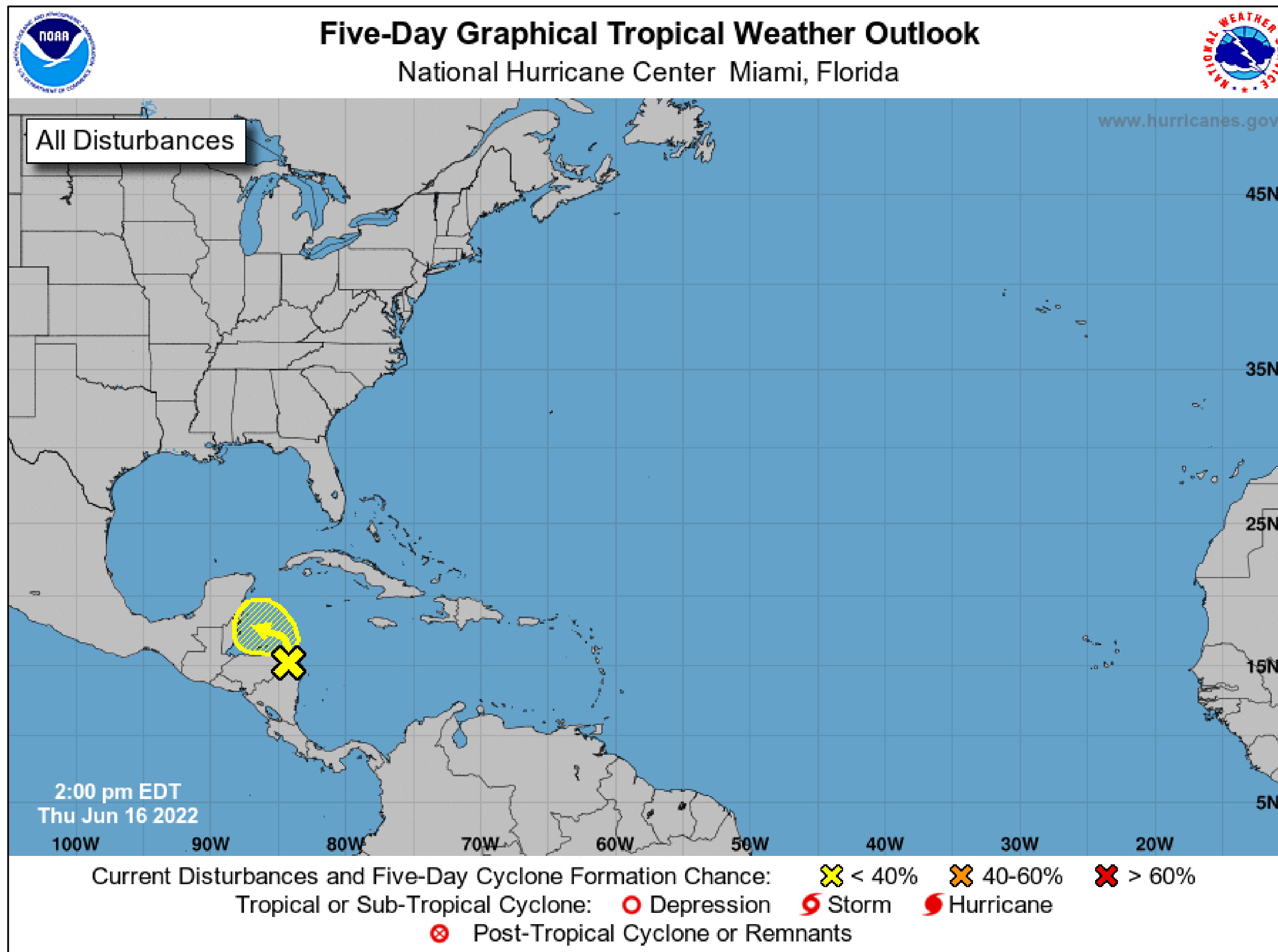

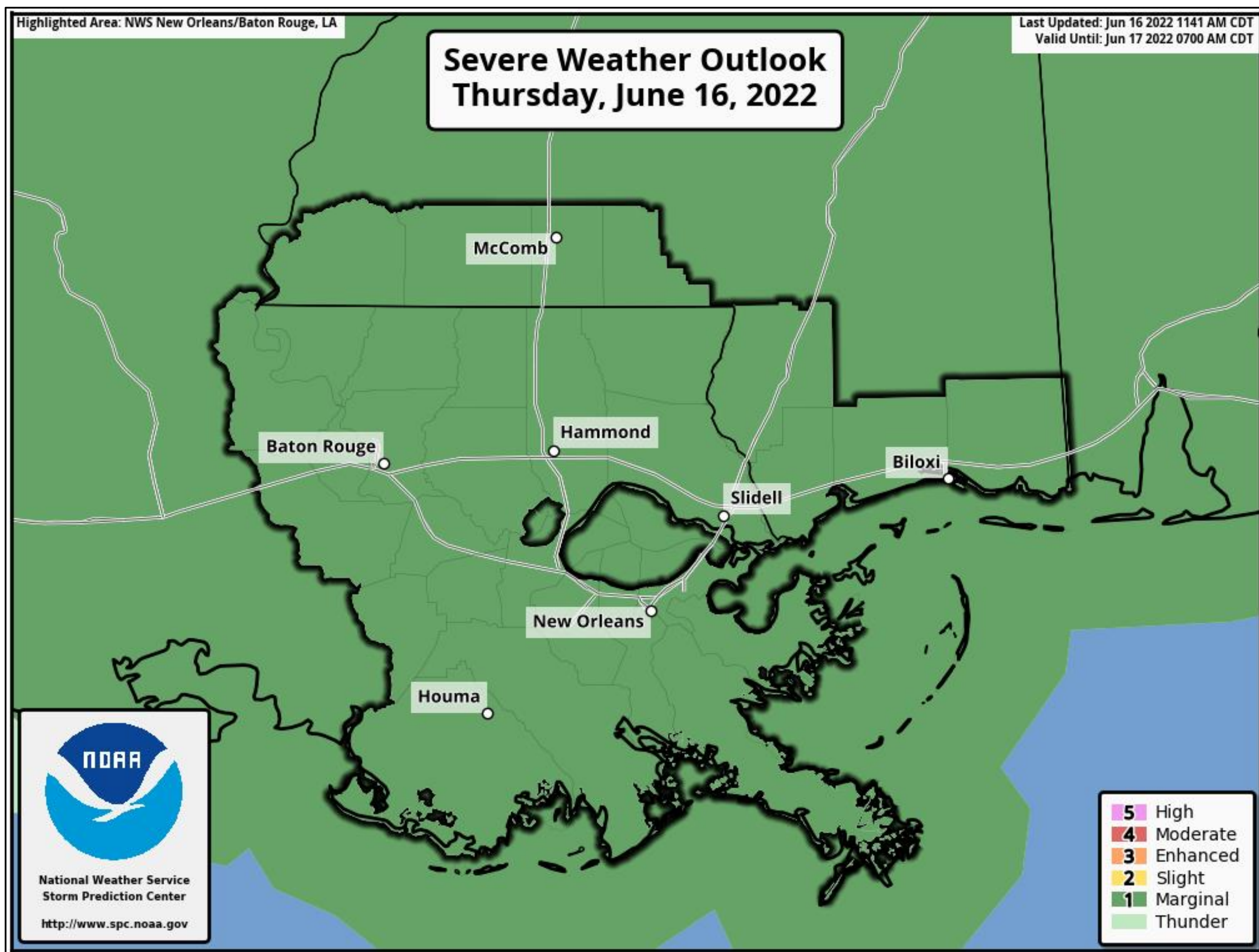
Tropical Weather Outlook

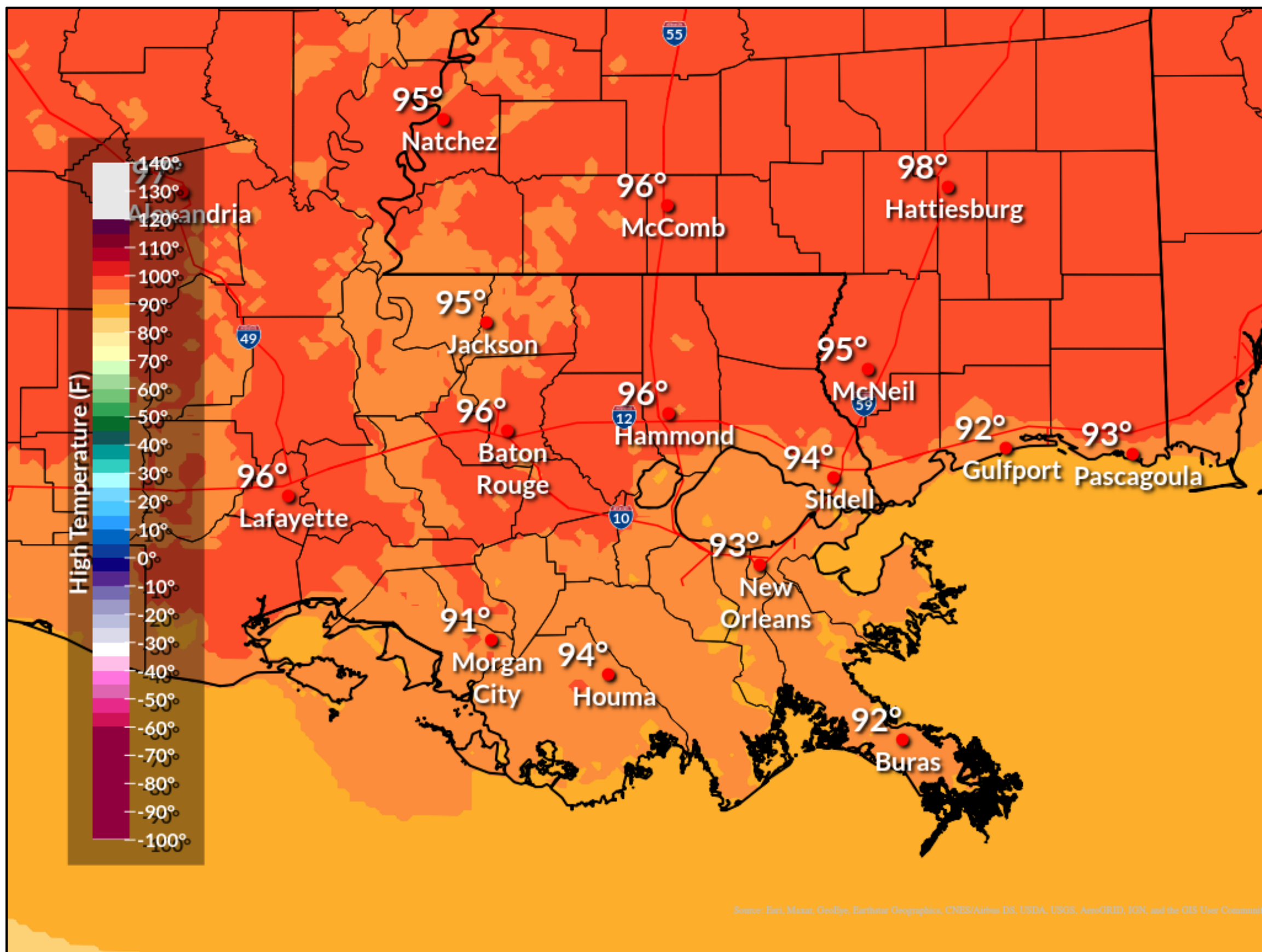

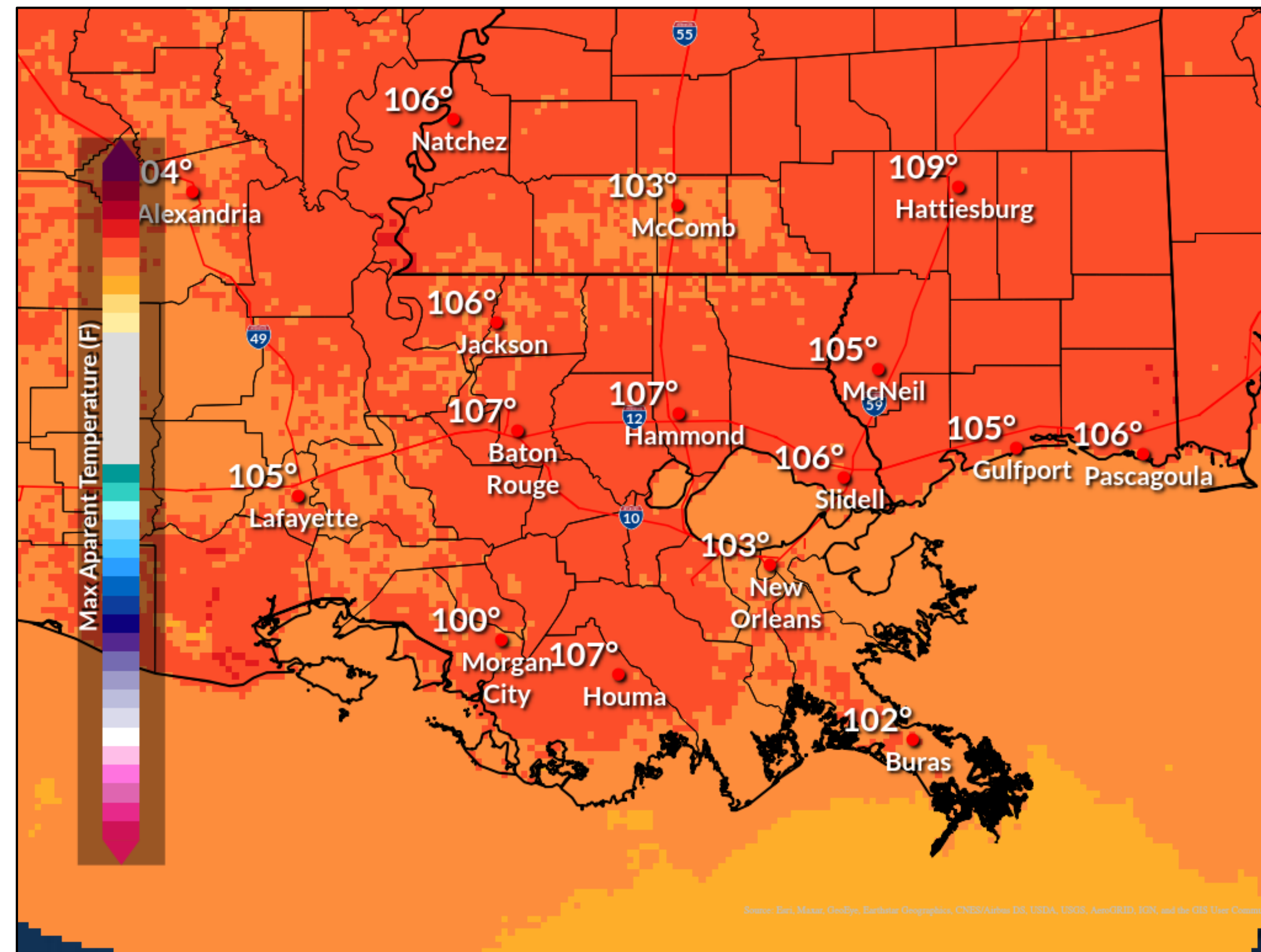
Maximum Temperature/Heat Index

Maximum Heat Index Forecast

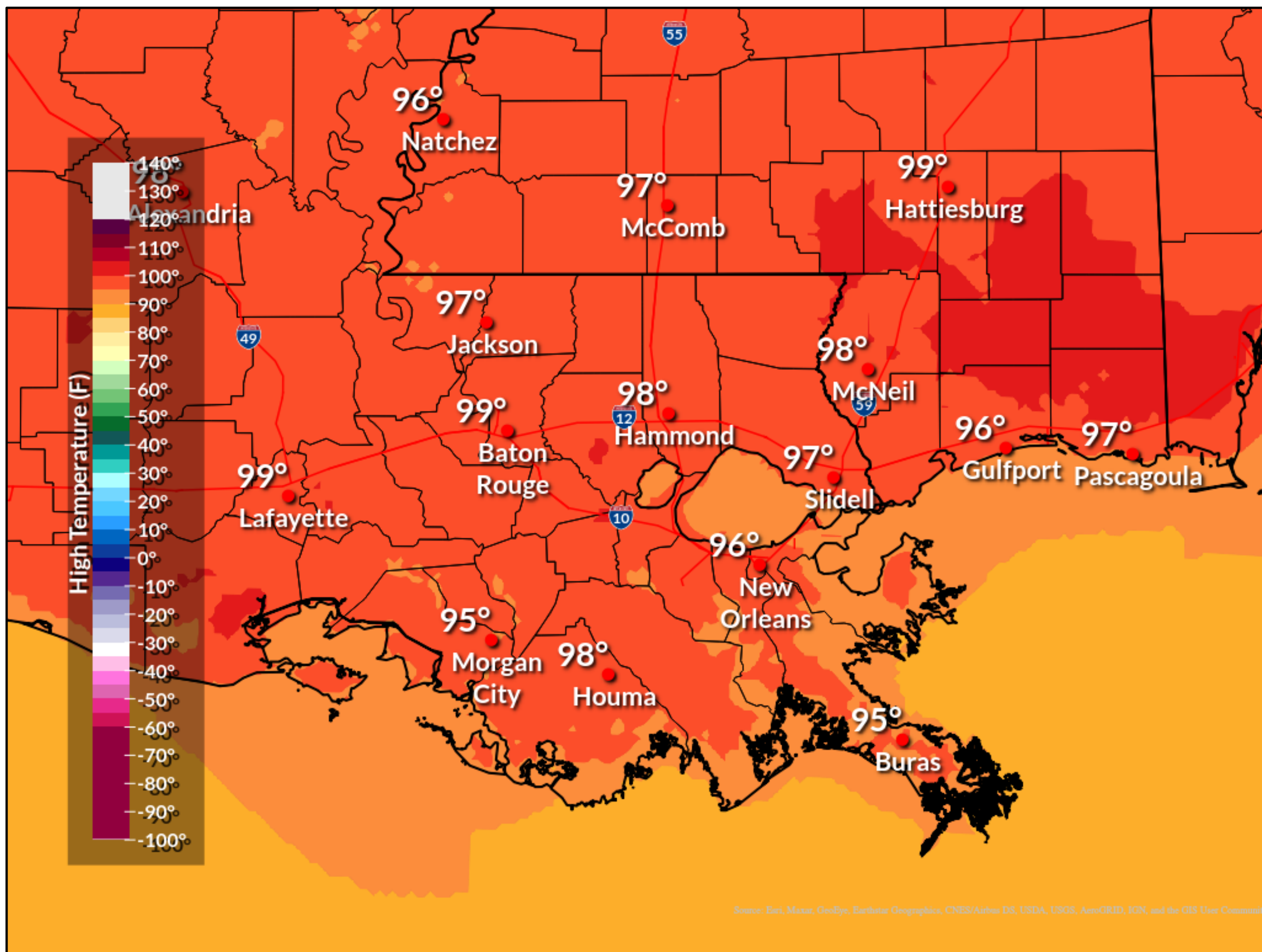




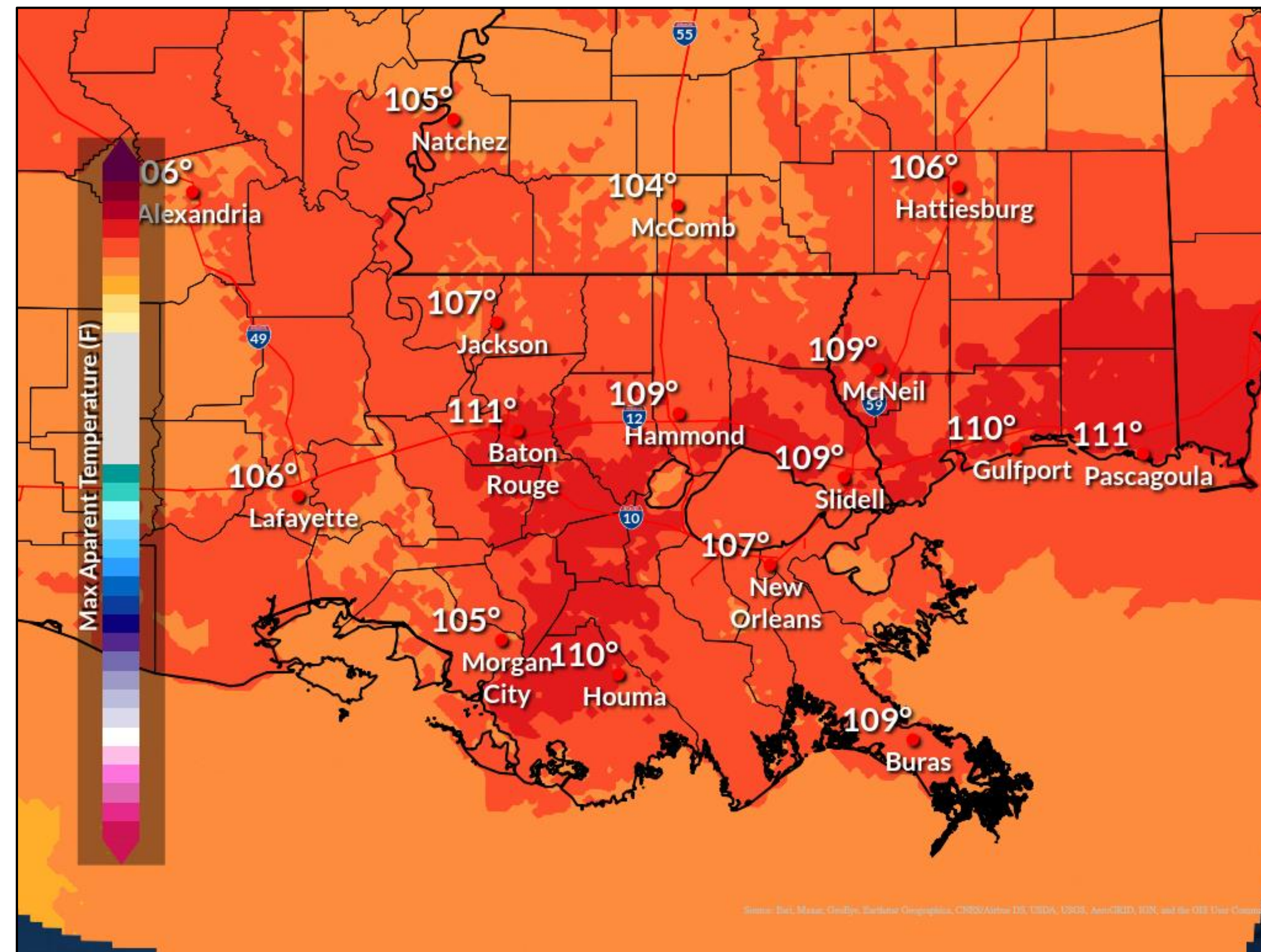
Maximum Temperature/Heat Index

Maximum Temperature Forecast

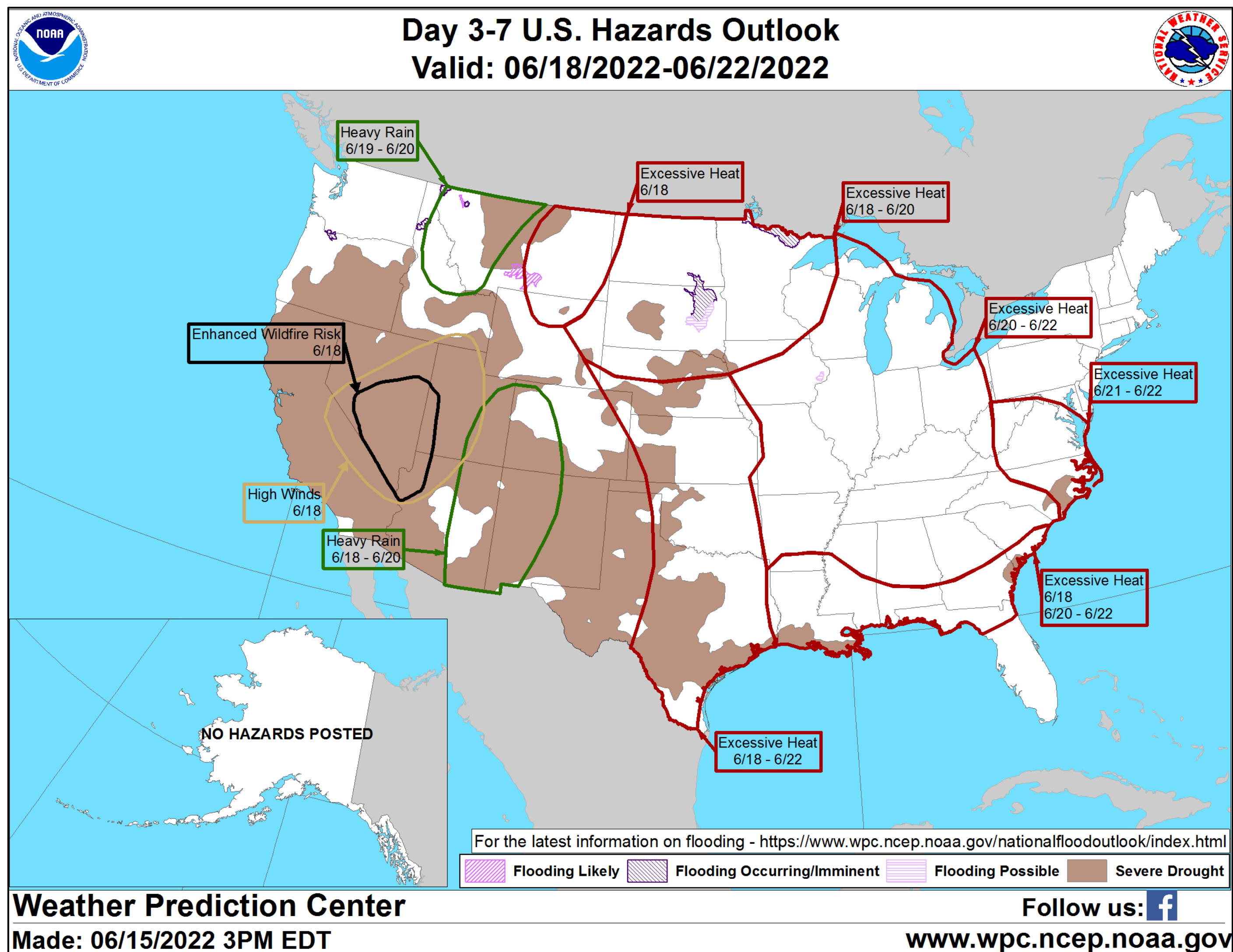


Maximum Heat Index Forecast





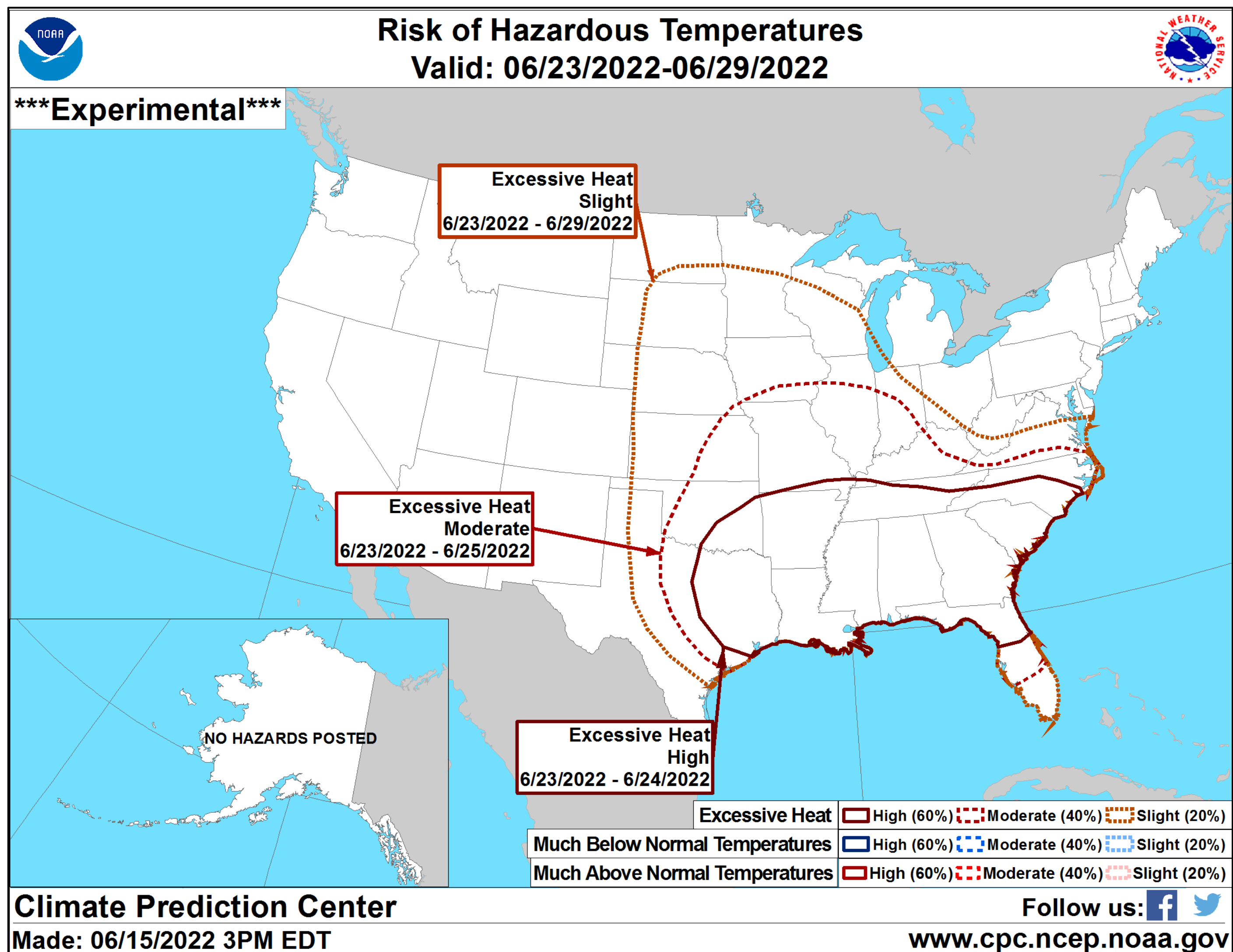
Day 3-7 Hazard Outlook
